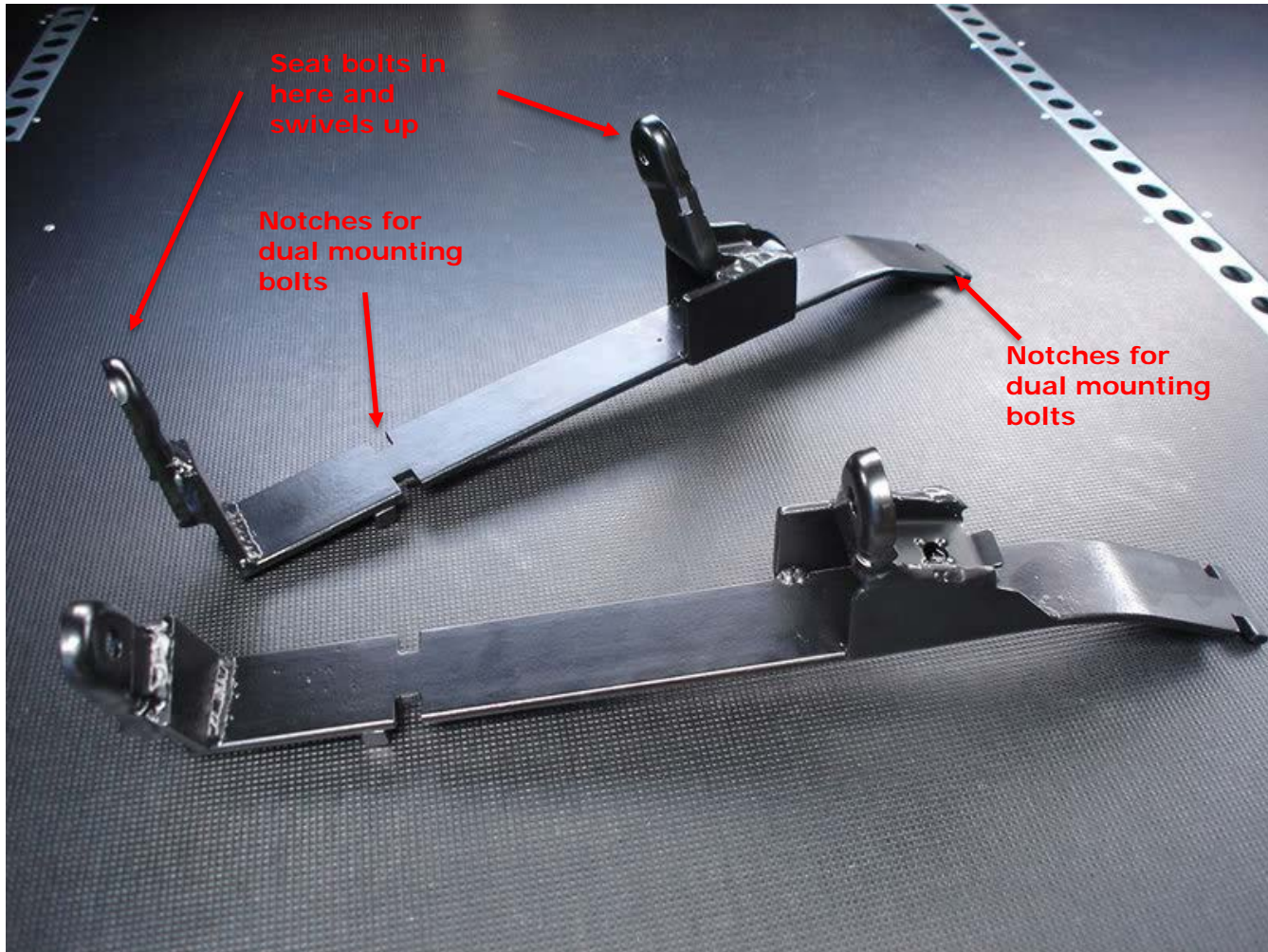


Delica Van Seat Modication – L400 Delica version (1993+) folding seats into L300 Delica version (1985-1992). 2 Brackets plus metal floor bar. **Andre 604 837 2995**



These are the brackets to copy that sit on top of the wheel well inside, and attach to pre-existing dual bolt mounts at each end (this is what the notches are for). I will provide my Van for the day with the two seats that will bolt into the vertical mounts.

This is the current seat in my Van. If it helps I could bring it in as you could measure the linear distance between the two mountain bolts



this is the end goal. I have the same seats as in picture and would provide with my Van for the day. L400 and L300 Delica Vans are same width.

Red line indicates the metal bar extension that folding legs would "click" into

Red line indicates the metal bar extension that folding legs would “click” into. I’d imagine you build the brackets first and then simply add on the metal bar once you figure out how to add on joint that connects up the brackets. I’d imagine there would have to be two bends to attach from floor up to the bracket. The original seats would click into a floor mount that does not exist in my Delica L300. The seat legs would “click” in (they are designed to do this) and this prevents them from collapsing. The bar also allow for only one seat to be folded down at a time.



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
